### **Matthew 25**

**35** For I was an **hungred**, and ye gave me meat: I was **thirsty**, and ye gave me drink: I was a **stranger**, and ye took me in:

**36** **Naked**, and ye clothed me: I was **sick**, and ye visited me: I was in **prison**, and ye came unto me.

**37** Then shall the **righteous** answer him, saying, Lord, when saw we thee an **hungred**, and fed thee? or **thirsty**, and gave thee drink?

**38** When saw we thee a **stranger**, and took thee in? or **naked**, and clothed thee?

**39** Or when saw we thee **sick**, or in **prison**, and came unto thee?

**40** And the King shall answer and say unto them, Verily I say unto you, Inasmuch as ye have done it unto one of the least of these my brethren, ye have done it unto me.

**41** Then shall he say also unto them on the left hand, Depart from me, ye cursed, into everlasting fire, prepared for the devil and his angels:

**42** For I was an **hungred**, and ye gave me no meat: I was **thirsty**, and ye gave me no drink:

**43** I was a **stranger**, and ye took me not in: **naked**, and ye clothed me not: **sick**, and in **prison**, and ye visited me not.

**44** Then shall they also answer him, saying, Lord, when saw we thee an **hungred**, or **athirst**, or a **stranger**, or **naked**, or **sick**, or in **prison**, and did not minister unto thee?

**45** Then shall he answer them, saying, Verily I say unto you, Inasmuch as ye did it not to one of the least of these, ye did it not to me.

**46** And these shall go away into everlasting punishment: but the righteous into life eternal.

### **HUNGER AND THIRST IS IN NT "6" TIMES**

1. Blessed are they which do **hunger** and **thirst** after righteousness: for they shall be filled [**Mat 5:6.6**].

2. And Jesus said unto them, I am the bread of life: he that cometh to me shall never **hunger**; and he that believeth on me shall never **thirst** [**John 6:35.19**].

3. Therefore if thine enemy **hunger**, feed him; if he **thirst**, give him drink: for in so doing thou shalt heap coals of fire on his head [**Rom 12:20.5**].

4. Even unto this present hour we both **hunger**, and **thirst**, and are naked, and are buffeted, and have no certain dwelling-place [**1 Cor 4:11.8**].

5. In weariness and painfulness, in watchings often, in **hunger** and **thirst**, in fastings often, in cold and nakedness [Adam] [**2 Cor 11:27.9**].

6. They shall **hunger** no more, neither **thirst** any more; neither shall the sun light on them, nor any heat [**Rev 7:16.3**].

**NAKEDNESS**

OT 1. Therefore shalt thou serve thine enemies which the LORD shall send against thee, in **hunger**, and in **thirst**, and in nakedness, and in want of all things: and he shall put a yoke of iron upon thy neck, until he have destroyed thee [**Deut 28:48**].

For I was an **hungred**, and ye gave me meat: I was **thirsty**, and ye gave me drink: I was a stranger, and ye took me in:

Naked, and ye clothed me: I was sick, and ye visited me: I was in prison, and ye came unto me [**Mat 25:35-36**].

Then shall the righteous answer him, saying, Lord, when saw we thee an **hungred**, and fed thee? or **thirsty**, and gave thee drink?

When saw we thee a stranger, and took thee in? or naked, and clothed thee? [**Mat 25:37-38**].

For I was an **hungred**, and ye gave me no meat: I was **thirsty**, and ye gave me no drink: I was a **stranger**, and ye took me not in: naked, and ye clothed me not: **sick**, and in **prison**, and ye visited me not.

Then shall they also answer him, saying, Lord, when saw we thee an **hungred**, or **athirst**, or a stranger, or **naked**, or sick, or in prison, and did not minister unto thee? [**Mat 25:42-44**].

NT **4**. Even unto this present hour we both **hunger**, and **thirst**, and are **naked**, and are buffeted, and have no certain dwelling-place [**1 Cor 4:11**].

NT **5**. In weariness and painfulness, in watchings often, in **hunger** and **thirst**, in fastings often, in cold and **nakedness** [Adam] [**2 Cor 11:27**].

### **BREAD**

OT **2**. And gavest them **bread** from heaven for their **hunger**, and broughtest forth water for them out of the rock for their **thirst**, and promisedst them that they should go in to possess the land which thou hadst sworn to give them [**Neh 9:15**].

NT **2**. And Jesus said unto them, I am the **bread** of life: he that cometh to me shall never **hunger**; and he that believeth on me shall never **thirst** [**John 6:35**].

### **HEAT NOR SUN**

OT **3**. They shall not **hunger** nor **thirst**; neither shall the **heat nor sun** smite them: for he that hath mercy on them shall lead them, even by the springs of water shall he guide them [**Isa 49:10**].

NT **6**. They shall **hunger** no more, neither **thirst** any more; neither shall the **sun** light on them, **nor** any **heat** [**Rev 7:16**].

Note:

"Hunger" is in the OT **13** times

"Thirst" is in the OT **20** times

= **33** = promise

We should hunger and thirst after righteousness, so we can get our promise, which is Jesus.
